Dear Senator Salazar:

I commend you for calling a spade a spade with your remarks re. James Dobson and his Focus on the Family. You have hit the nail on the head. But I soon discovered that there was a great disparity between the way they talked and the way they acted. Toward each other and toward the world.

This experience taught me a lesson that I've never forgotten. There is no more effective an arena for the Antichrist than to become clothed in religious rhetoric and pretense. To claim to represent the one true faith. This is exactly what the Dobson juggernaut has done. It is, in fact, a right-wing political/social/economic crusade wrapped in Christian language. It is the greatest of blasphemies!

Dobson is not representative of faithful Christianity. His violent, almost fascist approach to raising children, for example, is anathema to what Jesus said and taught. He must be openly confronted at every turn and identified for what he is. An impostor.
